SCIENCE LIBRARY

The Science Library houses most books and journals dealing with the sciences, including astronomy, biochemistry, biology, botany, chemistry, neuroscience, geology, paleontology, physics, physiology, zoology, and some areas of engineering and technology.

Some interdisciplinary materials, such as psychology, environmental studies and history of science are found in several libraries on campus. Branches of the Science Library include the Math Library, and the libraries at the Oregon Institute of Marine Biology and Pine Mountain Observatory.

The Science Library, located in the lower level between Science I and Science II, has hours from 8 a.m.-11 p.m. Monday-Friday; 9 a.m.-11 p.m. Saturdays; and 10 a.m.-11 p.m. Sundays.

MATHEMATICS LIBRARY

The Math Library, located in 210 Fenton Hall, is a branch of the Science Library and contains most of the University's resources in mathematics and computer science.

Some general materials on these subjects are found in the Science and Knight Libraries. Math Library hours are 8 a.m. - 9 p.m. Monday-Thursday; 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Fridays; and noon-5 p.m. Sundays (closed Saturdays).

ARCHITECTURE & ALLIED ARTS LIBRARY

The AAA Library will move to new quarters in 1990 as a result of renovations and additions to the School of Architecture and Allied Arts. When the building project is completed the library will be located in the new south addition to Lawrence Hall and will have twice as much space as it does now.

The library serves the departments and programs of the AAA School: Architecture, Interior Architecture, Art Education, Art History, Fine and Applied Arts, Historic Preservation, Landscape Architecture and Planning, Public Policy and Management.

Besides books and periodicals, the AAA Library houses slides, photographs and architectural drawings. AAA Library hours are 8 a.m.-11 p.m. Monday-Friday; 9 a.m.-11 p.m. Saturdays; and 10 a.m.-11 p.m. Sundays.

PUBLIC AFFAIRS LIBRARY

The Public Affairs Library, located in 130 Hendricks Hall, collects materials primarily in public policy studies, public administration, finance, and planning on the state and local government levels. There is also information about transportation, housing, energy and environmental issues. Library hours are 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Friday (closed on Saturday and Sunday).
