Art galleries decorate campus

Art and natural history museums outstanding in the Northwest

Museums and galleries can be found in just about every corner of the University.

In fact, the two most prominent museums in the region are found right on campus. The Museum of Art and the Museum of Natural History also are two of the most visible buildings at the University, not because of their locations but because of the architecture.

The Museum of Art, located directly across the quadrangle from Prince Lucien Campbell Hall, is probably one of the most prominent buildings at the University.

It also is one of the only buildings without windows — a feature that protects the works of art exhibited within the building.

This rather unique feature was what helped get the museum onto the National Register of Historic Places in June of 1986.


The Museum of Natural History is, on the other hand, located in the area that many students refer to as Siberia — out by the dormitory parking lots.
