

Summer Flashback

Summer entertainment in the Eugene came in a wide array of concerts and performances from folk at the Country Fair to bluegrass and classical in the Concerts In The Parks Series to a mural from Nicaragua at the EMU gallery.

The summer Concerts In The Parks Series brought bluegrass to Petersen Barn, a taste of the southern Louisiana bayou to Amazon Park, as well as 16th and 17th century classical to Hendricks

Park. The series is put on annually by the Eugene Parks, Recreation and Cultural service department.

Providing three days of entertainment for the 20th year, the Oregon Country Fair welcomed 35,000 spectators to its gates outside of Veneta from July 7 through July 9.

Also appearing at the fair were the nationally famous flying Karamazou Brothers, who performed a juggling act

and Tom Noddy, the bubble man, who provided a captivating display of capturing people inside his bubbles.

At the Lane County Fairgrounds the Lane County Fair entertained the public with displays games, rides and popular music artists.

The fair also had an unusual twist when the mayor of Springfield challenged the Mayor of Springfield, Mass. to break their record of 33,869, breakfast

The Emu Art Gallery's summer display was highlighted with a mural depicting Nicaragua in calmer times. The mural was designed by Chilean artist Pancho Letelier and was painted by Eugene residents in 1987 during Nicaragua Friendship day, an annual event to raise funds for humanitarian aid.
