Most campus dance clubs limited to older students

Although there are many places to dance in Eugene, minors may still have a difficult time gaining access to most of them.

Of these places, only one is open to people under 21.

The one dance club open to minors is Club Hollywood, 136 E. 11th Ave. The club is open Wednesdays from 9 p.m. to 2 a.m. at which time the cover charge is \$3.

Fridays and Saturdays the club is open from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. with a cover charge of \$5.

A variety of music is played at the club and the average age of the clientele in the late teens.

Although Club Hollywood is the only exclusively all-ages club in town, the W.O.W. Hall, 291 W. Eighth St., opens its doors to people of all ages for

most of its shows.

The W.O.W. Hall books a diverse array of acts from all different styles of music, and because of this the crowd there is constantly changing. There is usually a reasonable cover charge at the door for local acts (\$2 to \$5) and a larger charge for more well-known groups.

Although it is not a dance club in the strictest sense, there are many opportunities to dance to good music.

For those dance enthusiasts who are 21 and older, there are many more options to choose from.

Guido's, 13th Avenue and Alder Street, offers D.J. dancing Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays.

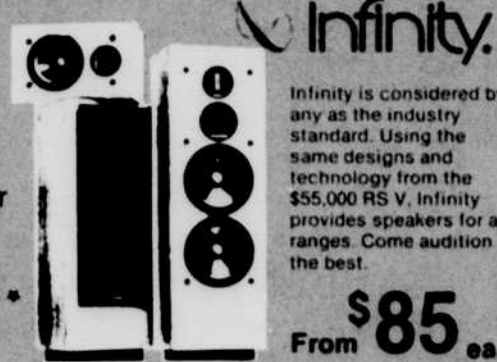

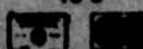

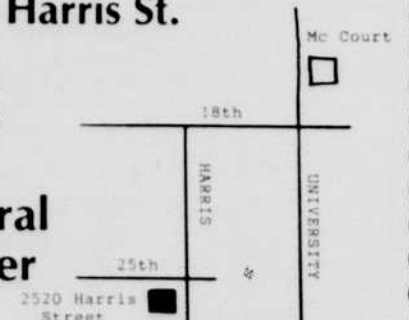
