Scandals nightclub, 2222 Centennial Blvd., has dancing to D.J. music seven nights a week. There is no cover charge and the crowd is made up mostly of college students and people in their mid-twenties.

Coconut Joe's, on top of the Hilton Hotel at 66 E. Sixth Ave., has popular music dancing with a D.J. every day of the week and there is no cover charge. Fridays and Saturdays the crowd is mostly college students.

Club Arena, 959 Pearl St., offers its patrons a 15 screen vid-

eo system to dance to. There is a \$1.50 cover charge Fridays and Saturdays and Manager Jerry Aldoroty said the "Euro-flash fusion" style of music that is played there is unique in the Eugene area.

Taylor's tavern, at 13th Avenue and Kincaid Street, is populated mostly by students and has good music, usually Rhythm and Blues, to dance to every night. There is a small cover charge at the door that is usually between \$1 and \$3.

Hopper's, 19th Avenue and Agate Street, is a music club open Thursdays through Satur-

days that offers a diverse range of music. It is frequented mostly by students and has a \$2 cover charge.
