**Women sing for scholarship fund**

It's 8:00 p.m. on a Monday night and the voices of more than 40 women echo through Beall Concert Hall.

But it's not a university choir. It's the Women's Choral Society of Eugene. Dedication has brought these women together this evening as it brings them together every Monday night when they hold rehearsals.

Other than for the mere enjoyment of being part of a choir, the ladies of the Women's Choral Society are together for a worthy cause — students at the University.

How are the two connected? All of the proceeds from their concerts and other appearances during the year go to a music scholarship fund.

Along with the many associated members and businesses who make contributions, the money earned by the Society creates three scholarships that are offered to University music majors each year.

While many choirs use their money to perform in costly concert halls, the Women's Choral Society spends only the minimum amount to save as much as possible for these scholarships.

"We're very low-budget and we give as

much to the students at the University of Oregon as we can, because that's the purpose of the group," said Sandy Kreiss, president of the Society.

The winners of the scholarship are chosen by auditions and by recommendation of a member of the auditioning voice faculty of the school of music. In the fall two scholarships are awarded; one to a new student and one to a returning student.

This fall's recipients are Laura Kirk, an incoming freshman from Coos Bay, and Lisa Bork, a returning senior who was also the recipient of one of last year's scholarships.

Bork said she appreciates the help she's received from the Women's Choral Society and said she feels they are a worthwhile group because they provide entertainment to the public as well as scholarships to University music majors.

"Their effort as an organization is to help other people and to help students out. I think it's so beneficial," she said thankfully.

The society still has openings for this year's choir and encourages University students to consider participating. Society rehearsals are Monday evenings at 7:30 in the music school, Beall Hall, Room 198.
