"The free tuition provides an incentive to stay here in Oregon," Sauceda added.

"I applied for the tuition wavier and was denied at first," said Nicole Muhammed, an award recipient. "Marshall called in June 1989 to offer me the award. Before then I was going to Portland Community College because that's what my financial situation was going to permit me to do."

Muhammad added that she

had almost given up on her dream to attend the University until she received the scholarship.

Although they had already planned to attend college in the state of Oregon, last year's recipients Tarra Withers and Anecia Burnett said the MASP scholarship helped sway their decision to enroll at the University.

MASP, formerly known as Minority Tuition and Fee Award Program, was established in 1987 by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education with the intent of increasing the enrollment of blacks, Hispanics and Native Americans at state universities.

Sauceda said the program was targeted at these groups because very few are pursuing their college education in Oregon. All 32 are attending the University this fall along with 70 other MASP recipients who are already in attendance. Sauceda said.



Resignation reviewed

SALEM (AP) — Oregon House Democrats will meet at the Capitol at 6 p.m. Thursday to review information about the resignation of the caucus administrator. House Majority Leader David Dix said Wednesday.

Dix said the caucus would get an update in the wake of the resignation of Carl Wiederaenders, who quit Monday amid ongoing questions about reporting of political contributions to House Democrats.

Wiederaenders said he mistakenly took a page from a caucus financial report he was examining in the secretary of state's office.

Secretary of State Barbara Roberts has asked the state police to investigate whether any laws were broken. She said Tuesday it appeared the missing page had been torn from the file.

Dix, a Eugene Democrat, said he believes Wiederaenders took the document by mistake.

Campaign finance documents are open to public inspection but can't legally be removed from the secretary of state's office without authorization.

Dix said he returned the page to the secretary of state's office immediately after he discovered Wiederaenders had walked away with it.

The caucus is under scrutiny for apparently not reporting some contributions, including one for \$10,000 from state Rep. Hedy Rijken, D-Newport.

The page Wiederaenders took from the secretary of state's office showed Rijken's donation hadn't been listed in the caucus financial report.


