

yards and an electrifying run of 45 yards by redshirt freshman tailback Ngalu Kelemeni.

After a Cusano sack stopped the next Arizona drive, the Ducks finished the game's scoring, driving 20 yards in six plays for a 42-yard McCallum field goal.

After each team wasted a possession, the Oregon defense was given the same kind of test it was given last week against Stanford. This time,

the Ducks got a passing grade. Arizona began what it hoped would be a game-winning drive on the Oregon 42.

The Wildcats began with a shovel pass from Veal to freshman running back Michael Bates for a gain of 7. Fullback Mario Hampton then carried for short yardage setting up a third-and-two at the Oregon 34.

With 1:27 remaining in the game, Arizona called timeout to discuss its play selection. After the timeout, the confused Wildcats were flagged for delay of game

Faced with third-and-long, Veal went back to pass, but was sacked by Oregon defensive end Andre Williams for a loss of 5 yards.

On a last gasp play. Veal attempted a keeper for a gain of 1. Oregon took over on downs and ran out the clock for the win.

The fact that the Ducks were able to pull out the win despite a less-than-impressive performance by Musgrave was not lost on Brooks

"That's as bad as Bill has played in a long time," Brooks said. "Thank God he (Musgrave) had a bad day and we won.'

Cusano's interception highlighted an outstanding day for the senior nose tackle. Cusano registered 14 tackles, including two tackles for loss and one quarterback sack to go with his interception. 'Without a doubt, that was Cusano's best

game of the year," Brooks said. He had a major influence in controlling the inside running game and also got out onto the perimeter some.

Cusano said that the loss to Stanford gave him and his teammates motivation going into the Arizona game.

I took it personally last week when we lost that game," Cusano said. "I wanted to make amends for myself and I think the rest of the defense did as well.

"We played well today," he said of the Duck defense. "We really took the game from them. This was the best defensive performance I can remember since I've been here.
