

Duck gridgers move into Top 25

Following Saturday's 16-10 win over 17th-ranked Arizona, Oregon, 3-1, moves back into the Associated Press Top 25 poll this week.

The Ducks jumped back into the Top 25 at No. 23 after falling out of the Top 25 following their loss to Stanford.

Oregon is one of four Pacific-10 Conference teams in the poll this week. Oregon will play Washington State, ranked 21st, at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at Autzen Stadium.

Kickoff was originally scheduled for 1 p.m., but was moved back so the game could be aired by the Prime Ticket television network, which televised the Arizona-Oregon game.

The Ducks have had good success against the Cougars in the past including a 43-28 victory in Pullman a year ago when both Latin Berry and Derek Loville had over 100 yards rushing. In fact, Oregon hasn't lost to Washington State since 1984.

Southern Cal is the Pac-10's top ranked team, tying for ninth after beating Washington State, previously 19th, on Saturday.

The Pac-10 had the most teams of any conference in the Top 25 with UCLA being the other conference team in the

poll. Notre Dame, 4-0, retained the top spot in the poll with 57 first place votes after thrashing Purdue 40-7. Miami, Fla. remained

No.2 while Big Eight powerhouses Colorado and Nebraska were third and fourth respectively. Michigan rounded out the top five.

Three Ducks get honors

It was definitely a successful weekend for Oregon athletes, as three Ducks walked off with Pacific-10 Conference Player of the Week honors.

Nose tackle David Cusano and kicker Gregg McCallum were the defensive and special teams Players of the Week. Meanwhile, Oregon's Michele Kresbach was the Pac-10's volleyball Player of the Week.

Cusano and McCallum played leading roles in Oregon's 16-10 win over Arizona that vaulted the Ducks back into the Associated Press Top 25 poll.

Cusano had 14 tackles against the Wildcats, two tackles for losses, a quarterback sack and an interception that set up a Duck touchdown.

Meanwhile, McCallum continued his stellar play for the special teams. McCallum scored 10 of Oregon's 16

points, converting three of three field goals, including a 42-yarder, and one extra point.

Kresbach garnered the volleyball award after leading Oregon to match victories over sixth-ranked California on Friday and eighth-ranked Stanford on Saturday in the Bay Area. Kresbach had 26 kills, 19 digs and five kills in the two matches, as the Ducks improved to 3-3 in Pac-10 play and 13-3 overall.

The lone Pac-10 Player of the Week who was not an Oregon athlete was University of Southern California quarterback Todd Marinovich, the offensive player of the week. Marinovich led USC to an 18-17 win over Washington State by throwing a touchdown pass with four seconds in the game, and then throwing a two-point conversion for the victory.
