

'Me and My Girl' to be featured at Hult Center

Play currently appearing on Broadway

The Broadway musical *Me and My Girl* will arrive in Eugene for a solo performance at the Hult Center's Silva Concert Hall this Thursday at 8 p.m.

Me and My Girl originally produced in London in 1937 has won three Tony Awards, Five Drama Desk Awards and the Laurence Olivier Award for best musical. Written by L. Arthur Rose and Douglas Furber the play also features wonderful musical scores by Noel Gay.

Directed by Joe Leonardo, *Me and My Girl* tells the story of free spirit Bill Snibson, a common fellow from the wrong side of the tracks who unwittingly has inherited the title Earl of Hareford.

At first befuddled with his newfound wealth, Bill learns quickly to enjoy the blueblood lifestyle. Then Bill learns that there are strings attached.

The heir (Bill) must be deemed a fit and proper person by the executors of the will. Thus begins Bill's lessons in the art of being a gentleman.

No problem thinks Bill. I can change. It will be worth it. Exit one problem, enter another. What about Sally, Bill's working class girlfriend? Surely Sally would never be accepted by the aristocrats of Hareford, or would she?

Enter Lady Jaqueline. After deciding she wants to marry Bill (solely for financial reasons), Jaqueline sets about the decadent task of seducing him.

It is this continuous game of cat and mouse between Bill and Jaqueline as well as the one between Bill and Sally that captivates the audience throughout the show.

Choreographer Dan Mojica does an excellent job to the tunes "The Sun Has Got His Hat On," "Take It On The Chin," "Once You Lose Your

Heart," and especially "The Lambeth Walk."

Me and My Girl is the first of three Broadway musicals to be featured at the Hult Center this season (Sept-May). The last Broadway show to appear at The Hult was "Cats" this past August. The Hult Center usually features 4-6 Broadway productions a year.

"Community interest in Broadway productions is very high," said Patricia Cusick, Hult Center assistant marketing director. "In response to this interest our 'In-House' programming office is very committed to bringing major Broadway productions to Eugene."

Me and My Girl is unique because it is simultaneously running on Broadway, in London, and on tour. This appearance at the Hult is an Oregon exclusive. Tickets are still available, and range from \$15-\$25. There are a limited number of student
