Ducks knock off Stanford, California; move into poll

Following victories over California and Stanford this past weekend, Oregon's volleyball team moved into the Tachikara/American Volleyball Coaches' Association Top 20 poll released on Tuesday.

The Ducks are ranked 19th in the poll after upsetting the Golden Bears, previously ranked sixth and the Cardinal, ranked eighth before falling to the Ducks. Stanford though improved to sixth in the poll while California fell to 10th.

Three other Pacific-10 Conference teams are also ranked in the poll. UCLA

checks in at No 2, Arizona is ranked seventh, and Southern Cal is No. 11.

Oregon, 3-3 in Pac-10 action, and 13-3 overall, will return to action tonight at Portland State. The Ducks then play Pac-10 rival Oregon State on Saturday in Corvallis.

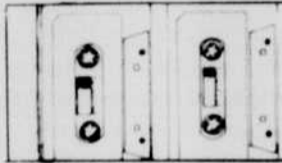
Also, on Monday, senior Michele Krebsbach was named Pac-10 volleyball player of the week.

Krebsbach garnered the volleyball award after leading Oregon to its victories over California and Stanford. Krebsbach had 26 kills and 19 digs.

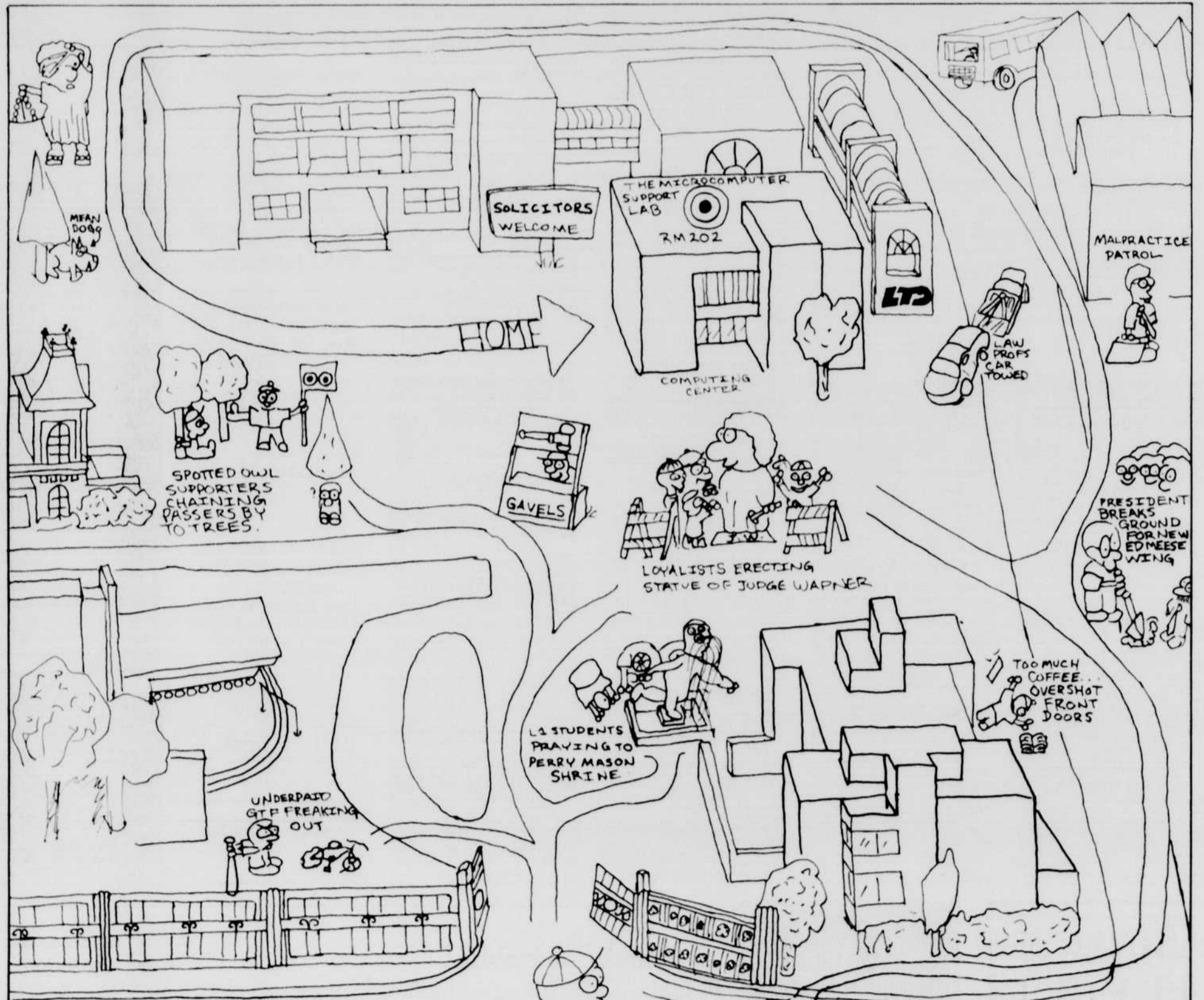
