After preparing for Arizona's explosive wishbone offense last week, the Ducks are readying for the high-flying Washington State passing attack for Saturday's battle with the No. 21 Cougars at Autzen Stadium.

"Even though we prepared for the wishbone, we still worked on our pass rush (last week)," LaBounty said. "The biggest thing is not changing too much. We can't give up the big play."

Even though Washington State's starting quarterback Brad Gossen is still out with an injury, LaBounty hasn't seen any differences between Gossen and the new Washington State signal caller, redshirt freshman Aaron Garcia.

"Like coach (Rich) Brooks said, you really can't tell the difference between the two," LaBounty said. "They still throw a lot of long balls. We just have to put some pressure on him."

LaBounty and the rest of the Ducks find themselves confronting an opponent coming off a crushing blow last week like Oregon did two weeks ago.

The Cougars lost 18-17 to USC on the last play of the

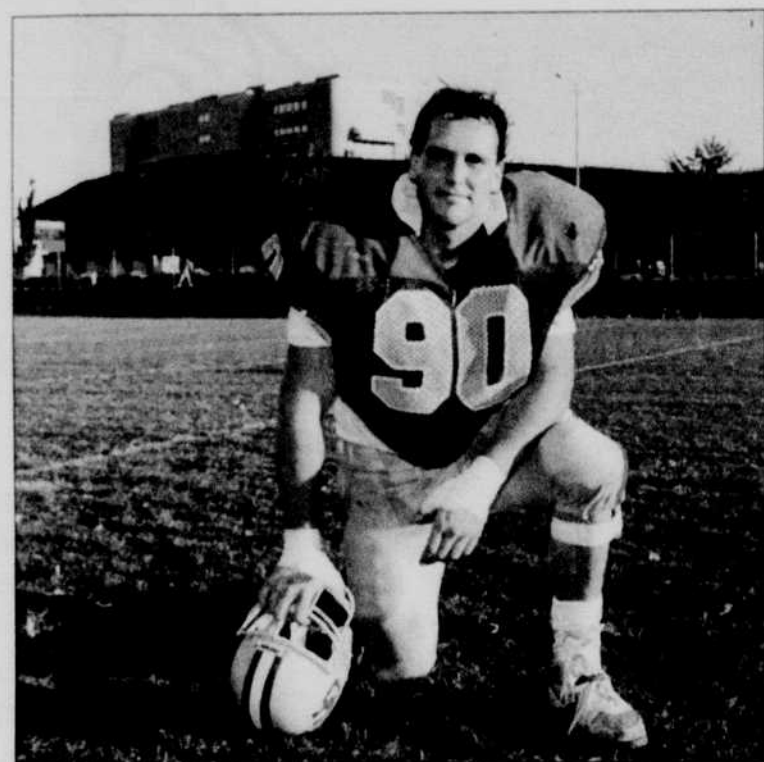

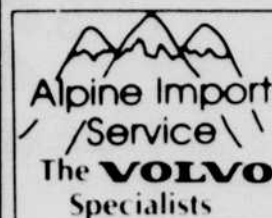
