suggestions for changing the way the Physical Plant hires employees so the appearance of nepotism is not present.

"There was nothing we could deal with at the present ... so we looked at the future and how we can prevent the appearance of nepotism in the future," King said.

Pat Lewis, the Physical Plant's Oregon Public Employee's Union representative, said conditions have been improving since Roach took over as in-

terim director.

"We were really pleased with the consulting report because we did have a lot of input into it," she said. "Mr. Roach has done what we think is an excellent job."

Lewis said Hecht was willing to continue the improvements begun by Roach.

Hecht, who is in Eugene now, will spend the first part of the month getting acquainted with plant personnel before taking over from Roach on Oct. 15.
