## Florence resident rests after shot by policeman

FLORENCE (AP) — A 20-year-old man shot in the hip by a Florence police officer was in stable condition Saturday in a Eugene hospital.

Florence Police Chief Chris Mathieson said Darrin Condley of Florence was wounded Friday night after he threatened officer Steven Fandrey with a knife.

Fandrey was about to go off duty late Friday when police received a report from people leaving a high school football game of a man waving a knife and threatening passers-by, Mathieson said.

"He was holding the knife up in the air and muttering and screaming. The officer told him to drop the weapon numerous times," Mathieson said.

Fandrey backed away until he was forced against his patrol car before firing his gun, the chief said.

"He was more than justified in shooting him. He could have killed him, but that is not our intent. The intent was only to stop him," Mathieson said.

Lane County Deputy District Attorney Jim Hunt and the state police are investigating the shooting, Mathieson said.
