community is getting tired of it," Garoutte said.

As recently as June 1988, Garoutte said, the Big Brother-Big Sister program operated from three local offices: one in Springfield, one in north Eugene and one in EMU Suite 1.

The north Eugene program had been funded with money from school district 4J, but in June 1988 the district announced it could no longer sustain it, Garoutte said. The Springfield office was paid \$10,000 to take over the program, and the incorporation of the programs became Big Brother/Big Sister of Mid-Oregon, she said.

"We lost a lot of visibility, and unfortunately, in this community it's out of sight, out of mind," Garoutte said. "We need to be noticed."

The Big Brother/Big Sister office in the EMU moved from Suite 1 last spring, but another office will open elsewhere in the EMU in a matter of days, Garoutte said. The University program is supported with incidental fees, she said.

"Fifty to 75 percent of big brothers and big sisters come from the U of O," she said. "We are looking to open our

(University office), come up with more visibility, and be able to participate more consistently with university life."

Big Brother-Big Sister of Mid-Oregon receives no federal, state or local public support, Garoutte said. Money is raised from mail and phone drives, fund-raising events, and a used-book store in the Springfield Mall, among other sources, she said. The Springfield office serves four counties.

The program is one of 14 high-priority areas for funding from United Way of Lane County, said Lisa Durham, director of marketing and communication for the local chapter.

United Way of Lane County raised \$1.6 million in 1988 and \$1.9 million this year for human service programs, Durham said. The group allocated \$7,356 to Big Brother/Big Sister of Mid-Oregon in 1988 and \$7,625 this year.

Financial need for different programs varies, Durham said. "It's hard to compare one agency to another because it depends on how many people they're helping and how much they're requesting," she said.
