Zusman said that a number of Portland institutions and banks refuse to advertise in

Willamette Week because the publication prints person-to-person ads for gays and lesbians.

The myth that "journalism is basically unimportant" is also untrue, Zusman said. Zusman cited the news reports exposing Watergate, Iran-Contra and the ongoing Housing and Urban

Development Agency scandals as proof that journalism is anything but irrelevant.

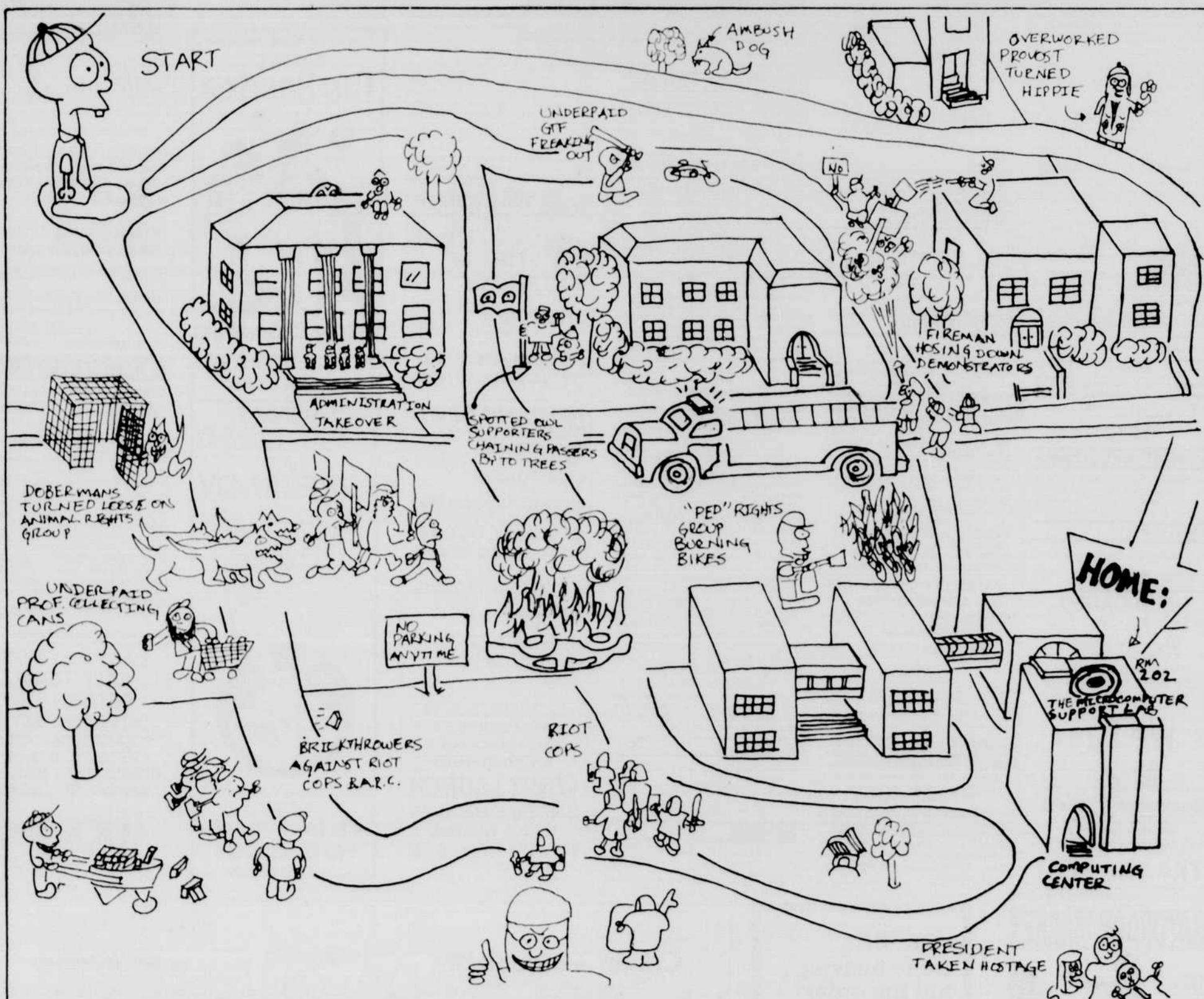
