Police Beat_

The following is a list of campus area crimes taken from the Office of Public Safety and Eugene Police Department reports between Oct. 31 and Nov. 14.

- A juvenile was arrested, and another juvenile cited and released, for theft of bike parts by EPD on Nov. 10. After questioning, the subjects led EPD to the Footbridge area, where an EPD officer noted some bike parts in the brush. The items were seized and taken to EPD for storage. A complete bike was also recovered from the same area. The incident is believed to be possibly related to a rash of bike part thefts this month.
- Two quick-release pins worth \$16 were reported stolen to EPD on Nov. 13. The pins had been removed from the tires of a bike at Deady Hall.
- A bike rack and both tires and tire rims from a touring bike at Henderson Hall were reported stolen to OPS on Nov.
 The parts were worth \$160.
- The front and rear brakes of a mountain bike at 13th Ave. and Kincaid St. were reported sto-

len to EPD on Nov. 8. In addition, the brake cables were damaged. The brakes were worth \$150.

- Mountain bike parts worth
 \$389 were reported stolen to
 EPD on Nov. 8. The tires,
 derailleur, handlebars and
 brakes were removed from
 Gerlinger Hall.
- Both wheel rims and the bike seat of a mountain bike at EMU were reported stolen to OPS on Nov. 9. The parts were worth \$200.
- A bike seat from Carson Hall was reported stolen to EPD on Nov. 3. The seat was worth
 \$30.
- A set of handlebars, hand brakes and a gear chain from a mountain bike outside Villard Hall were reported stolen to OPS on Nov. 2. The parts were valued at \$300.
- A theft of a camera, a jewelry box and a wallet containing \$150 in cash from Willcox Hall was reported to EPD on Nov.
 The owner was not sure whether the room was locked or not.
- A wallet, purse and change purse worth a total of \$440

from Stafford Hall were reported stolen to OPS on Nov. 13. The owner was not sure whether the room was locked or not.

- A theft of a wallet and purse from Esslinger Hall was reported to EPD on Nov. 7. The wallet, containing credit cards and \$35 in cash, was left on a chair and concealed by a briefcase and a coat. The owner left the room for 10 minutes and returned to find the purse and wallet gone.
- A case of criminal mischief in Douglass Hall was reported to OPS on Nov. 7. A resident assistant called about some graffiti on the third floor stairwell from Oct. 24. Photos of the graffiti were taken and turned over to EPD, where they were determined to be gang-related, with references to the Bloods and the Crips.
- EPD arrested a subject for trespassing at Tingle Hall on Nov. 4. The subject awoke an RA after entering the RA's unlocked room at approximately 10 a.m. The subject, not a University student, reportedly said he was looking for someone to sell marijuana to.
