since 1964, if the Ducks can beat Oregon State in Autzen Stadium Saturday. Oregon is hoping to avenge last year's 21-10 Beaver victory that ended the Beavers' 13-game winless streak in the Civil War.

"The whole team is excited about this weekend," Obee said. "We've lived in humiliation for a whole year.

"We know we need to play harder and better against them because they're better this year than past Oregon State teams," he added. "We know if we play the best we can it will be impossible for them to beat us."

Although Obee might not be a big target at 5-foot-11 and 183

pounds, Ramsdell doesn't think his size will be a hindrance in the NFL.

"The biggest thing the pros look for are explosiveness and quickness and Terry's not the most talented in that aspect," Ramsdell said. "There's a lot of guys in the pros that are smaller than Terry. He's strong and durable and has compact size.

"He's outstanding catching the ball and going after it, and he's great getting the extra yardage after the catch."

Despite what happens after the Civil War game and in the NFL, few people will ever forget Terry Obee's accomplishments as a Duck.

Tickets for game gone

(AP) — Saturday's Oregon-Oregon State football game in Autzen Stadium has been declared a sell-out by University officials.

The last of the standing-room-only tickets for the 93rd Civil War game were sold Wednesday, assuring that the attendance will exceed 46,000 the officials said.

That turnout would be an Autzen Stadium record and the largest crowd to watch a football game in the state.

Autzen Stadium established its record attendance last season when 45,978 spectators were on hand for the Oregon-Washington game.

The largest crowd to watch an Oregon-Oregon State contest was 43,157 in 1987, the last time the teams met in Autzen Stadium.

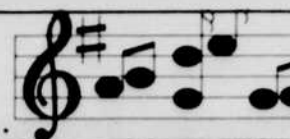
