Ducks Civil after 30-21 triumph

What appeared to be a rout-in-the-making Saturday turned into a real battle as Oregon beat Oregon State 30-21 in the 1989 Civil War football game in Autzen Stadium.

Oregon held a 16-0 lead late in the third quarter and appeared headed for more when Oregon State safety Billy Hughely intercepted a Bill Musgrave pass at the Beaver 20-yard line and returned it 57 yards to the Oregon 23.

Three plays later, Beaver quarterback Nick Schichtle hit split end Maurice Wilson from 25 yards out for a touchdown. Schichtle was filling in for starter Matt Booher, who injured his knee in the first quarter.

Fullback Pat Chaffey ran the two yards for a two-point conversion to bring Oregon State within eight at 16-8 with 1:44 left in the third quarter.

A pass interference call on the touchdown play and an unsportsmanlike penalty on the extra point took the Oregon State kickoff to the Oregon 35

where the Beavers attempted an on-sides kick. Oregon receiver Tony Hargain recovered the line-drive kick at the Oregon 21.

Oregon, led by the passing of quarterback Bill Musgrave, the receiving of Terry Obee and the running of Latin Berry, then marched 79 yards in nine plays for a touchdown and a 23-8 lead with 12:58 remaining in the game.

The scoring play was a spectacular catch by Obee in the right corner of the end-zone over Beaver cornerback Brian Beck. Obee said later that Beck had the interception, but he simply took it away from the Beaver defender for the score.

On the drive, Musgrave completed three passes to Obee for 53 yards and the touchdown. Berry's 12 yards rushing on the drive helped set up the 24-yard scoring play.

Oregon State, with the help of sloppy special teams play by the Ducks, came right back to pull within 23-14 on a one-yard scoring plunge by Chaffey with 10:01 remaining. The two point conversion attempt was not good.

The Beavers started the drive

on their own 43 after Hughely returned the kickoff 32 yards to set up the 57-yard scoring drive.

Oregon State's defense then stopped the Ducks on their next possession, forcing a Marc Penso punt that Beaver flanker Reggie Hubbard returned 23 yards to the Oregon 47.

Schichtle then hit tight end Phil Ross for a 19-yard gain and a first down at the Oregon 28. After a four-yard gain by Chaffey and an incomplete pass, Schichtle combined with Chaffey for a 24-yard touchdown pass. Troy Bussanich's extra point made it 23-21 Oregon with less than eight minutes remaining.

Bussanich drew consecutive five-yard penalties on the ensuing kickoff for kicking the ball out of bounds. Russell Lawson then took the kickoff at his own 21 and scampered 22 yards to the Oregon 43, setting up the Ducks' drive for an insurance touchdown.

After an incomplete pass, tailback Derek Loville, who rushed for 111 yards for his third straight 100-yard Civil

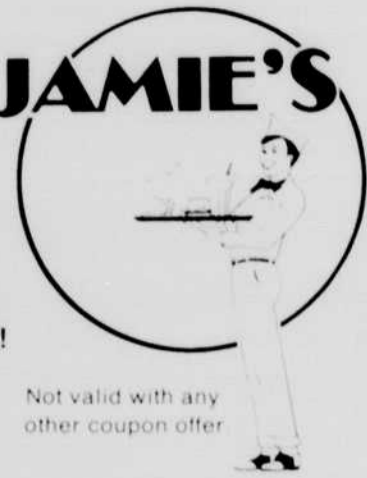

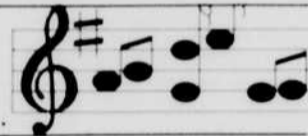

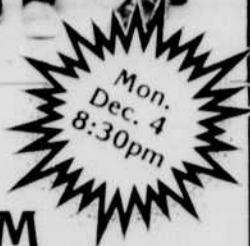
