

Duck runners finish second behind Iowa State

Iowa State's top-ranked men's cross country team proved the pollsters right Monday by taking the national title in the NCAA meet in Annapolis, Md.

Oregon, ranked No. 2 in the nation, finished second, just eight points behind the Cyclones, in what turned out to be a two-team race for the title.

John Nuttall and Jonah Koech of Iowa State finished 1-2 in the meet to pace the Cyclones.

Oregon's highest team finishers were Brad Hudson at eighth place in a time of 30:01.1, with Peter Fonseca and Pat Haller at 16th and 17th, respectively, to round out the Ducks' top 20 finishers.

Iowa finished the meet with 54 points, followed by the Ducks with 72. From there, scoring dropped dramatically with Wake Forest and Washington at third and fourth with 219 and 224 points, respectively.

Oregon entered the meet confident after its historic sweep at the Region 8 meet 10 days ago. But the 1-2 finish for the Cyclones in the race proved too much for the Ducks to overcome.

Nuttall, a senior from Preston, England finished the 10,000 meter course in 29:30.55. Koech, a native of Kenya, finished second in 29:32.69. German Beltran, a native of Venezuela who runs for Alabama, finished third with a time of 29:33.

Iowa State's Darrell Smith finished 11th overall, and seventh among the 154 team participants. The Cyclones placed five runners in the top 23 finishers in team competition to edge the Ducks.

Among the runners competing individually, the top finisher was Louisiana State's Terry

Thornton, who finished fourth overall in 29:49.75. Thornton, like Nuttall, is a native of Preston, England.

Bob Kennedy of Indiana, who won the race last year as a freshman, was the first U.S. runner across the finish line at fifth in a time of 29:54.30.

Other Oregon finishers were Terrance Mahon at 27th, Danny Lopez at 44th, Steve Richards at 48th and Eric Peterson at 73rd.

Oregon was attempting to win its fifth national title. The Ducks were NCAA champions in 1971, 1973, 1974 and 1977.

Villanova's Vicki Huber won the women's title, covering the 5,000 meter course in 15:59.86 to lead the Wildcats to their first-ever team championship. Huber's time was the fastest in nine years of women's competition.

Villanova placed three wom-

en in the top 20 with Kathy Franey finishing 11th overall, ninth among team competition and Sonia O'Sullivan finishing 26 overall, 18th in team competition.

Oregon's Stephanie Wessell, the lone Duck competitor, finished 58th with a time of 17:50.85.

The Wildcats finished with 99 points followed by Kentucky with 168 points. Villanova

placed three runners in the top 20 in team competition.

Kentucky's Valerie McGovern placed second in the race in a time of 16:26.78. Defending meet champion Michelle Dekkers of Indiana finished third in 16:36.52.

Susan Bliss of Missouri placed fourth overall in 16:43.83, best among those competing on an individual basis.

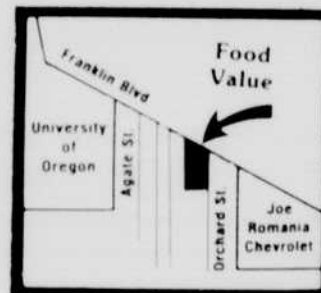
