Keillor to return to airwaves

Garrison Keillor returns to the airwaves of KLCC 89.7 FM with his all new program Garrison Keillor's American Radio Company of the Air on Saturday. Nov. 25 at 6 p.m.


"The impulse of the show is so uncomplicated." Keillor said in a press release. "It's slightly embarrassing to put it down on paper. We want to do a live Saturday-night show from New York that is funny and happy, hype-free, and full of classical American music of all kinds, performed by the best people we can find, and to give our audience, in millions of homes (of all kinds), a radio show that will make them glad they didn't go to the movies."

Lake Wobegon will be part of the show, as well as some other elements from Keillor's former radio show, A Prairie Home Companion. The music will not limited folk/stringband/country as before, and the show won't focus on performers so much as on a body of classical music

The program will be broadcast live from New York's Brooklyn Academy of Music.

The format is that of a twohour live variety show. Classical American music including theater music, popular songs, jazz and folk - will comprise over an hour of the total broadcast time, with the remainder a blend of Keillor's humor, writings, and interplay with his special guests and other Radio Company members.

Keillor's American radio Company of the Air will alternate with rebroadcasts of A Prairie Home Companion, sharing the same time slot of 6 to 8 p.m. on Saturday nights. The new program will run for four consecutive weeks beginning Nov. 25, followed by several weeks of A Prairie Home Companion, after which the new show will resume.
