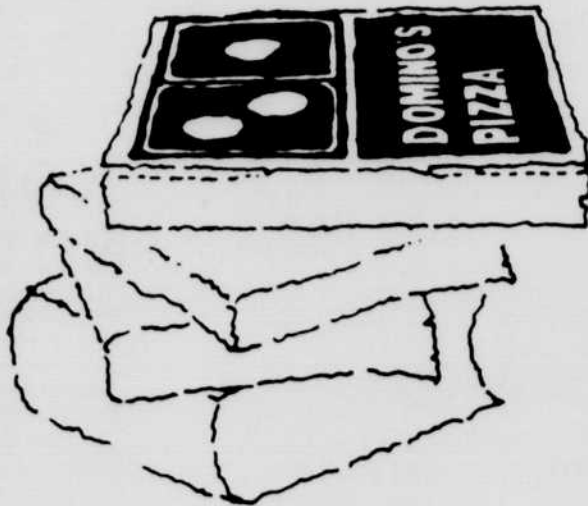
A **penance service** will be held tonight at 7:30 at the Newman Center, 1850 Emerald St. All are welcome to attend.
