two chances to tie. but Sun Devil forward Mark Becker missed a layup and Brandon rebounded the miss with :06 left.

Brandon was fouled on the rebound and again after the inbounds play, but missed the front end of the one-and-one with four seconds remaining to give the Sun Devils one more chance. But Becker's three-point attempt came after time expired, sealing the Duck win.

The victory completed a Mac Court sweep of the Arizona schools, the first such sweep since 1987. Oregon State also beat Arizona Saturday to complete a four-game sweep of the Arizona schools by the Oregon schools.

The wins over the Wildcats and Sun Devils also gave Oregon its first 2-0 start in Pac-10 play since the 1981-82 season, a season when they also swept the Arizona schools for a 2-0 start.

The two Austins (Alex and brother Isaac) combined for Arizona State's first seven points as the Sun Devils jumped out to an early 7-2 lead. But Oregon guard Kevin Mixon scored seven straight for Oregon to give the Ducks their first lead at 10-9 with 11:37 remaining.

Arizona State took a threepoint lead at 26-23 on Anderson's lay-in with 2:06 remaining in the half, but Brandon hit a basket to draw Oregon to within one at 26-25. That would prove to be the Sun Devils' last lead.

Brandon hit two free throws. and center Richard Lucas scored inside to give Oregon a 29-26 halftime advantage.

Isaac Austin scored eight of his 12 points in the first eight minutes of the second half as the Sun Devils struggled to within one at 41-40 with 12:24 remaining in the game. Mixon and senior forward Keith Reynolds each responded by scoring four points to lead the Ducks on a 12-4 run for their biggest margin of the game.

Frieder, who left Michigan just before last year's NCAA Tournament to take the job at Arizona State, said the Sun Devils played the kind of game it had to for a chance to win.

"We played the type of game that we had to play." Frieder said. "We executed offensively and defensively and we rebounded about as well as this team is going to.

"We took 15 seconds off the clock every time down the floor to shorten the game a little," he said. "We got good shots because we were patient. I'm proud of the way we played tonight. We played well when we were behind and didn't quit."

Mixon and Lucas chipped in 11 points each for the Ducks while Reynolds added 10. Forward Eric Dunn scored all eight of his points in the second half. Alex Austin led the Sun Devils with 20 points followed by Isaac Austin with 12.

Duck notes: For the second straight game, freshman Bob Fife turned in a solid performance. Fife, who has become a crowd favorite at McArthur Court, scored two points, grabbed two rebounds, had two assists and blocked a shot in nine minutes of playing time.

The Ducks travel to Birmingham, Ala. to meet the Alabama-Birmingham Blazers on Tuesday. Oregon hosts Utah Thursday and Portland on Saturday.


