

## A classy finish in the Classic

The Fred Meyer Far West Classic basketball tournament, in Portland's Memorial Coliseum, Dec. 27-29, couldn't have ended better for its sponsors and fans.

Oregon State blew by Boston University and nipped Louisiana Tech while Oregon

stopped Northeastern and Illinois State to set up a Civil War final.

The Beavers led by as many as 15 points heading into the final 10 minutes, but the Ducks, behind the play of sophomore guard Terrell Brandon and senior forward Keith Reynolds, stormed back to within one at 69-68 with 44 seconds remaining. The Ducks had a chance for the win, but Brandon's short shot in the lane missed. Junior center Richard Lucas grabbed the rebound but was tied up for a jump ball, giving possession to the Beavers.

Oregon State's star guard Gary Payton hit two free throws with less than six seconds remaining, giving the Beavers a 71-68 win.

For their excellent play, Brandon (above) and Reynolds were named to the all-tournament team. Brandon finished the tourney with 59 points and 20 assists; Reynolds chipped in 59 points and 20 rebounds.
