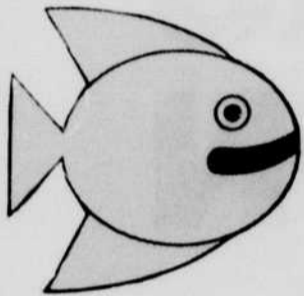

Activities aimed at raising AIDS awareness scheduled this month

The University and Lane County communities are "Taking AIM" this month to promote education and discussion of the many issues surrounding the AIDS crisis.

Through a series of exhibitions, workshops, theater, film and video presentations, Aids Information Month in Oregon will offer students a chance to gain straight-forward information about the HIV virus, clear up misconceptions concerning it, and become involved in helping to identify potentially risky behavior.

The month of awareness will tie in with an ASUO winter symposium Jan. 26-27 that will address various AIDS topics ranging from substance abuse to the government's response to the problem.
