Faculty members receive Fulbrights

Two more University faculty members have been awarded Fulbright scholar grants to teach and do research abroad during the 1989-90 academic year.

Jane DeGidio, director of the Office of Student Development, and Geraldine Moreno-Black, an associate professor of anthropology, are among 900 American scholars, academics and professionals being sent overseas as Fulbright scholars.

DeGidio and Moreno-Black are the eighth and ninth University faculty members to be honored this academic year.

DeGidio, also a courtesy associate professor in the Division of Educational Policy and Management, is ending her fall term stay in Swaziland near South Africa. While there, she joined with the dean of students at the University of Swaziland to develop a student affairs division.

Her research interests include exploring multicultural issues in higher education and increasing knowledge of problem solving in a multicultural environment.

Moreno-Black, a physical anthropologist, will travel to Thailand and Indonesia this spring to survey food markets for the prevalence of wild food as an income generator. She will also try to determine how this wild food is used both for eating and for medicinal purposes.

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
