"Religion and HIV" is the topic of a roundtable discussion including local religious leaders to be held tonight at 7:30 at the Koinonia Center.

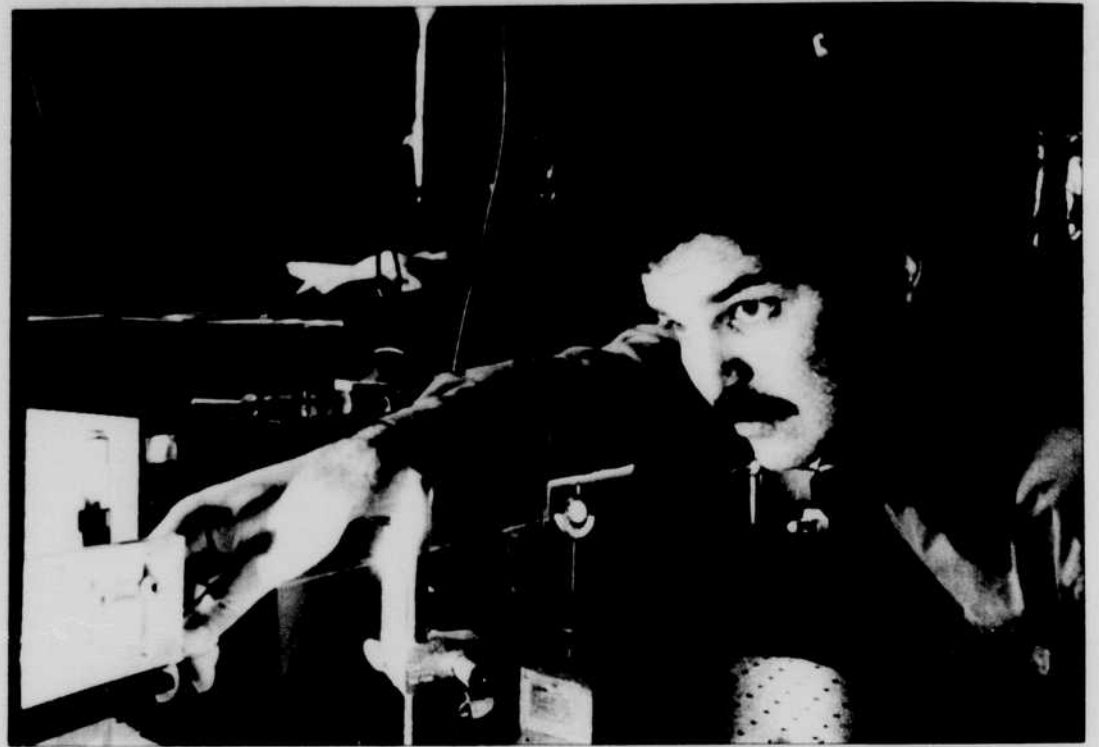
