Women netters post two wins

It was just fun and games for the Oregon women's basketball team this weekend after disposing of state rival Oregon State Friday night and drubbing Rutgers Sunday.

Rutgers, a team which has appeared in the NCAA tournament four straight years, was given a rude send-off back to the East Coast by the Ducks Sunday in McArthur Court. The Ducks simply outplayed the Lady Knights, tallying a final score of 92-78.

The difference in the game was at the free throw line with the Ducks sinking 30 of 41 free throws for a 73.2 percent mark. Four players fouled out of the game for Rutgers.

Rutgers, on the other hand, was given only 12 attempts at the line, capitalizing on nine of them.

Sophomore center Marne Smith had a career evening for the Ducks, sinking a career-high 17 points in just 14 minutes of play. Smith tied her career rebound mark with five while sinking seven of eight free throws.

"She's looked very good lately in practice the last couple of weeks and we thought she would really come in and perform," Oregon coach Elwin Heiny said. "With Stephanie (Kasperski) getting in foul trouble, obviously it was the right time and she really performed well."

Smith left the game with an injured foot with her prognosis not available by press time.

Senior center Kasperski led all scorers with 19 points, shooting a perfect seven for seven from the field. Senior guard Michelle Eble tossed in three of six three-pointers and tallied 15 points while freshman point guard Vanessa Selden contributed 13 points and five assists.

Rutgers opened up a 10 point lead of 21-11 at 10:47 of the first half before the Ducks got warmed up. Oregon ran up 13 straight points behind two three-pointers and two free throws by Eble to grab the lead at 27-21 with 7:57 remaining in
