

incredible numbers of people to live desperate lives and to face injustices of all kinds."

She said the United States has the resources and should be channeling them into "not the arms race, but the human race."

Her father's final campaign focused on what he called the "poor people's campaign," in which he envisioned a program of "massive civil disobedience" that would force Washington to make the nation's poor its first priority, she said.

"When you understand how potentially dangerous that cam-

aign was, then perhaps you will understand why the bullet came," King said.

King urged the audience to

will rise," King said.

After King's speech, Eugene Mayor Jeff Miller presented the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Leadership Award to Ruben Cota, director of the Chicano Affairs Center in Eugene. Miller praised Cota for his extensive community involvement.

The celebration also included musical performances by the Inspirational Sounds Gospel Ensemble and a blues dedication by Curtis Salgado.
