

Drug manufacturing dumps hurting outdoors

SALEM(AP) — Illegal drug manufacturers are adding to the natural hazards of the outdoors with some deadly, artificial ones.

About a dozen dump sites with refuse from laboratories used to produce methamphetamine and other drugs were found on federal lands in Oregon in 1989.

The wastes include chemicals that can maim and kill, cause cancer and birth defects and catch fire and explode.

"It's an extreme health hazard," Carola Stoney, a forest special agent for the U.S. Forest Service, said in a recent

interview. "Even touching some of the chemicals could be fatal."

"We used to tell our people to pick up garbage. Now we tell them not to touch it."

Most of the abandoned material is sludge and rinse water, said Ed Wilson, an environmental specialist with the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.

"After the cooks have gone through the process, they take the chemistry equipment out in the woods and push it out of the back of the car," he said.

Gary Rundell, an environmental pro-

tection specialist with the federal Bureau of Land Management, said odds are rising that recreational outdoor users will run across one of the deadly dumps.

"There's no doubt about it, it's getting worse," he said.

In 1989, drug lab dumps were found in the Willamette National Forest east of Eugene, near Bend in the Deschutes National Forest and in three ranger districts of the Mount Hood National Forest.

Drug makers used a Forest Service cabin as a lab in one case, said Mike

Powers, a special agent for the Mount Hood National Forest.

Rundell said six to 10 illegal dumps are being found each year on BLM land, mostly in the Roseburg, Medford and Eugene areas. Many of the sites are discovered in the spring as the snow thaws.

Wilson said the best policy for anyone who finds a suspected drug lab dump is to follow the guidelines for state and federal workers who spend time in the woods — stay well away and report the exact location to the state or local police.

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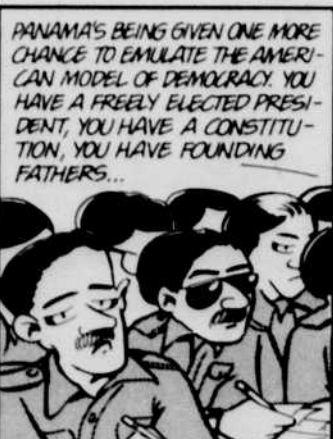
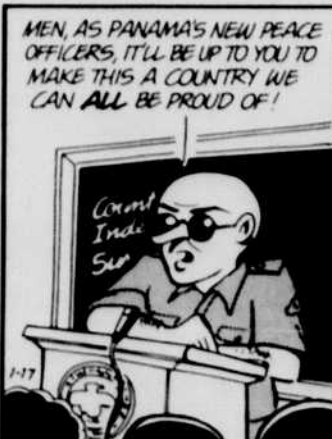
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
