At the beginning of her final season, Semeniuk was third on the all-time assist chart at Oregon with 371. The versatile player also led the team in assists for the second year in a row (41) and was third in rebounding (5.7).

All of these on-court accomplishments have not distracted Semeniuk from her studies, however. A physical education major, Semeniuk maintains a 3.72 GPA. That mark earned her second-team academic all-conference honors last year.

Scoring wise, Semeniuk is not always at the top for the Ducks, but her presence is a big factor. She averages 32 minutes a game, and with good reason. When Semeniuk is not in, the Ducks tend to falter.

"I feel she is the one player that we normally need in the game to have a consistent game," Heiny said. "Usually

elementary school in grade six and went on to an all-star career at Kelowna High School.

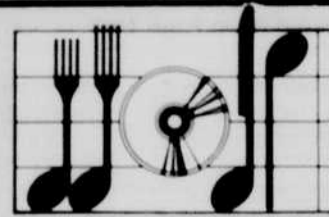
Semeniuk was named to the Okanagan Conference all-star team her last two years and was named the province's 1986 MVP.
