Semeniuk nearly perfect in win

Women over Arizona 84-73

The Oregon women's basketball team ran its winning streak to four games with a win over Arizona Thursday in Tucson. The loss was the Wildcats' fifth straight.

Jacquie Semeniuk was nearly perfect in leading the Ducks, 5-2 in the Pacific-10 Conference and 12-5 overall, to the win. Semeniuk was 5-for-6 from the field, 10-for-10 from the line.

had 20 points, 10 rebounds, seven assists and three steals in 37 minutes of playing time.

Trina McCartney was the Ducks' leading scorer with 21 points and also chipped in seven rebounds. Guard Vanessa Selden and Center Stefanie Kasperski had 16 and 15 points, respectively. Kasperski shared the team lead with Semeniuk in rebounding with 10 as Oregon outrebounded Arizona 43-37.

McCartney opened scoring in the game with a layup, but Arizona answered with 10 straight points to make it 10-2 with a little over three minutes gone.

Oregon then outscored the Wildcats 8-2 to pull within two at 12-10. That would be Arizona's last lead.

Marne Smith scored from 10 feet out to tie it at 12. Then Kasperski and McCartney each scored to make it 16-12 Oregon. The Ducks then went on to take a 10-point lead at the half at 38-28.

McCartney led Oregon in the first half with 14 points. As a team, Oregon shot 47.4 percent from the field to Arizona's 42.4 percent. The Ducks dominated the boards, outrebounding the Wildcats 23-15.

Selden scored with 16:07 left in the game to give Oregon a

17-point cushion at 51-34.

Arizona crawled to within 11 at 59-48 with 11:14 left, but Oregon scored seven straight to take its largest lead of the game at 66-48 with 9:26 remaining.

Arizona went on a nine-point run of its own to pull within nine at 68-57 and got to within eight at 70-62, but could pull no closer as the Ducks hit eight free throws down the stretch to ensure the win.

Semeniuk scored 14 of her 20 points in the second half, including all 10 free throws. As a team, Oregon hit 17 of 22 charity tosses in the second half and shot 53.8 percent from the field.

Semeniuk averages 8.9 points per game on 40 percent shooting, but has been on a tear in the team's last two games. She has scored 24 and 20 points in the wins over UCLA and Arizona, respectively. She has hit 14 of 22 shots from the field and 14 of 15 free throws in the two games.

Guard Timi Brown led the Wildcats with 21 points followed by Brenda Freese with 15.

Duck Notes: Oregon leads the series with Arizona 8-1 with the Wildcats' only win coming last season in Tucson.

Oregon travels to Tempe for a Saturday game with the Sun Devils of Arizona State.
