# Wrestling squad to host Vikings

Fresh off its third place finish in the Oklahoma State Cowboy Classic last weekend, the Oregon wrestling team will be hosting Portland State tonight at 7:30 p.m. in McArthur Court.

Oregon beat Portland State 32-12 Nov. 10 in Portland. The Vikings, 4-13 for the season, are led by NCAA Div. II nationally ranked wrestlers Broderick Lee and Dan Russell.

Lee, 18-3 on the year, is ranked No. 1 at 126 pounds. Russell is 20-4 and rated first at

158 pounds.

Oregon takes to the road for a meet in Ashland with Southern Oregon State on Saturday at 7:30 p.m. The meet with Southern Oregon, which wrestles in the NAIA division is something of an annual event for the Ducks, but was canceled last year due to heavy snow in the state, including the Eugene area.

Southern Oregon is led by 142-pounder Scott Johnson (13-6), 158-pounder Jeff Marshall (13-1), 177-pounder Clint

Woodward (13-5) and 190-pounder Jim Nicholl (13-5).

Oregon, led by the sixth-place ranking of 118-pounder Dan Vidlak, is ranked 23rd in the latest Amateur Wrestling News poll. The Ducks are 7-1 on the season, 3-1 in the Pacific-10 Conference.

Vidlak is 15-5 this season followed by 177-pounder Curt Strahm at 14-6-1. Joe Rissone, wrestling at 190 pounds, is 13-5 while 150-pounder George Johnston is 12-6-1.

Brandon had 14 points, four assists and two steals for Oregon, but also had four turnovers.

The Ducks also saved themselves at the free throw line, making 17 of 23 attempts for a 73.9 percentage for the game. That compared with a 42.1 percent mark by the Cardinal who sank just eight of 19 attempts.

Stanford shot 48 percent from the floor on 24-50 for the game.

Rebounding troubled the Ducks against the bigger, stronger Cardinal. Oregon was outrebounded 36-28 and gave away numerous scoring opportunities on the offensive end.

"We just don't fly enough and I didn't get enough help from the guards on the boards," Monson said. "But (Stanford's) the best rebounding team in the league and we're the worst rebounding team in the league."

Oregon did a great job of

shutting down the Cardinal big men inside, most notably 6-foot-9, 230-pound Adam Keefe. Keefe, who averaged 20.3 points per game coming in, finished with 13 points and five boards.

"He's the league's leading rebounder, averaging over 20 points a game and he's a great player," Oregon center Richard Lucas said. "I had to get around him a lot and got some fouls, but if that's what it takes to try and keep him from scoring I'll take some fouls."

Lucas saw the press as a key to Oregon not only turning the game around, but getting the 7,520 fans in Mac Court riled.

"We did a great job with (the press)," Lucas said. "That really gets us pumped, those turnovers and things like that. When we get those turnovers and the crowd gets going, the Pit just comes alive."

Lucas wrapped up the game nicely. "No matter how bad

you play, when you come away the winner when the buzzer goes off, who cares?" Lucas said.

Oregon plays host to California Sunday at 3 p.m. Cal lost 98-81 Thursday to Oregon State.




