answered it right, I got to throw a pie in my opponent's face," Talty said.

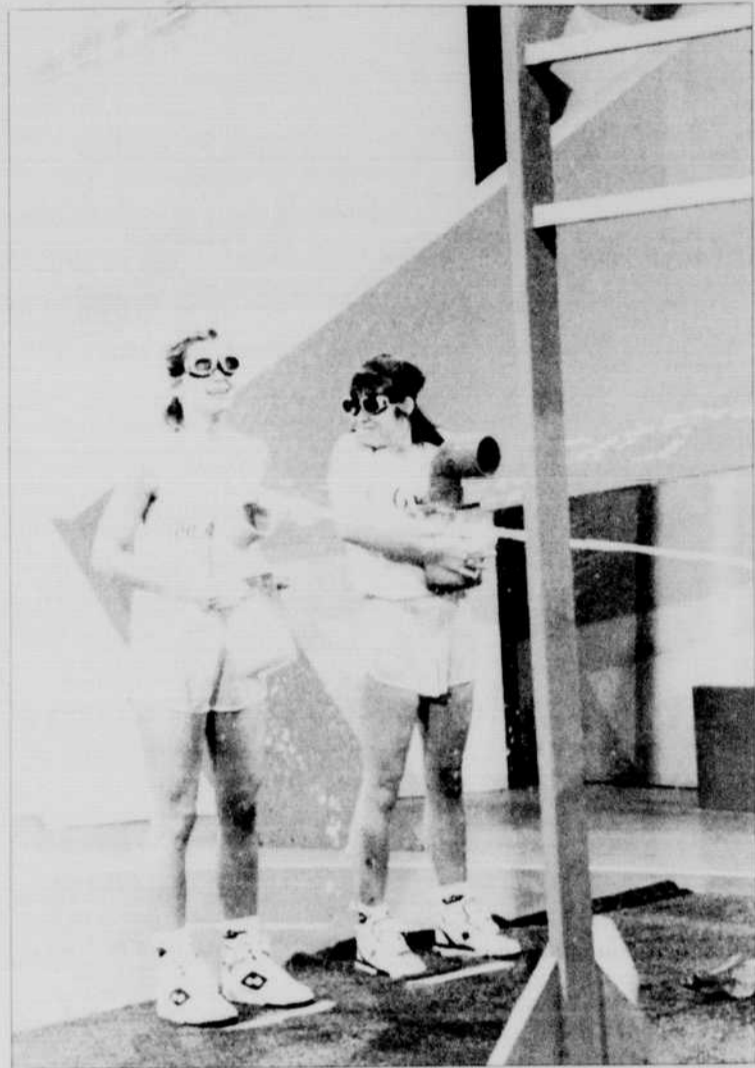
Unfortunately by the end of the round University of Washington had 200 points and the University of Oregon still had 75 points.
