

Cota intends to sign with Ducks

Ashland's Chad Cota, one of the premier prep players in the state this season, will reportedly sign a letter-of-intent with Oregon Feb. 14, the national signing date, according to the *Register-Guard*.

The 6-foot-1, 185-pound Cota was a key player on the Grizzlies Class AAA state championship team this season. Cota had four interceptions for Ashland and was named the Class AAA defensive player of the year by *The Oregonian*. Cota was also a wide receiver on offense for Ashland.

The announcement of Cota's intent to sign with the Ducks gives Oregon a second commitment from a key in-state prospect. Last week Roseburg's Heath Howington announced he would also attend Oregon.

In addition to Cota coming to Oregon, three more offensive linemen will reportedly come to Oregon giving the Ducks verbal commitments from 13 high school seniors and six junior college transfers.

Leif Jacobsen, a 6-7, 270-pound high school senior from Palmer, Alaska, said he will come to Oregon next season along with David Cuttrell, a prep senior from El Toro, Calif. and Jeff Cummins, a junior college player at El Camino Col-

lege in Torrance, Calif. who will transfer to Oregon.

Jacobsen grew up in LaGrande and is one of only 18 seniors named Northwest Nuggets — top college recruits — by the *Tacoma News Tribune*.

Cuttrell is the three-time student body president at El Toro High School and was named to the *Tacoma News Tribune's* Western 100 list as a top college prospect.

Cummins was the defensive player of the year in the Mission Valley Conference while playing for El Camino College this past season, the same school where current Duck basketball players Eric Dunn and Kevin Mixon began their college hoop careers.

Cummins, who went to Torrance High School, was also recruited by UCLA. On his way to conference defensive player of the year honors he led his team in sacks and had three interceptions as a defensive end.

Others giving verbal commitments to Oregon include D.J. Cabera, an all-state defensive lineman from St. Louis High School in Honolulu; Mark Slymen a 6-3½, 245-pound defensive lineman from Mission Vallejo, Calif.; Dwayne Jones, a 6-2, 217-pound fullback from LaPuente, Calif.; and Dan Meade a 6-4, 215-pound linebacker from Thomas Jefferson High School in Federal Way, Wash.
