



## Run to promote women's sports

Walkers and runners will promote "National Girls and Women in Sports Day" in a free, non-competitive race to be held Thursday afternoon.

The two-mile race is sponsored by the University Recreation and Intramurals program and the women's rights task force Creating A Rape-free Environment.

The run begins at 3:30 p.m., and the walk will begin five to 10 minutes later, after the runners have cleared out of the court, said race director Dene Eller.

The event, held for the first time this year, is the next step in raising awareness after this fall's CARE week, said Shaun Davis, intern to University Unwanted Sexual Tension Task Force chairperson Shirley Wilson.

The walk/run also provides an opportunity to make people aware of services and to network with other crime prevention organizations, said Shelly Reeher, founder and coordinator of Project Safe Run.

One of the goals of the race is to attract a diverse group of people. Eller said.

"We extend an open invitation, (and) men are encouraged to come and participate," Eller said.

AT&T and Nike are providing free advertising and prizes at the event, said Karla Rice, University Recreation and Intramurals director.

In addition, AT&T representatives will hand out information cards and will donate 50 cents to Womenspace for every card filled out and returned, Rice said.

PSR will give presentations at the race including Several Project Safe Run dogs, Reeher said.

Eller said the idea for the race was inspired by "National Girls and Women in Sports Day," which celebrates women's contribution to sports.

"We know a lot of people around here walk, so it seemed fitting," Eller said. "I thought it would be neat to have a race on campus, (which) could give chance for exposure to the task force."

The Office of Public Safety is lending its support by monitoring the race.
