
University



Run to promote women's sports

Walkers and runners will promote "National Girls and Women in Sports Day" in a free, noncompetitive race to be held Thursday afternoon.

The two-mile race is sponsored by the University Recreation and Intramurals program and the women's rights task force Creating A Rapefree Environment.

The run begins at 3:30 p.m., and the walk will begin five to 10 minutes later, after the runners have cleared out of the court, said race director Dene Eller
