Club volleyball team in action

The Club Sports men's volleyball team will meet a team from the Eugene Downtown Athletic Club Wednesday at 7 p.m. at McArthur Court in a fund-raiser for the upcoming nationals tournament in Tennessee.

The men, fresh off an "A" league tournament win last week in Portland, sport an 8-0 record coming into the match with the Athletic Club, which won the 1989 AA Regional Championship and features Oregon volleyball coach Gerry Gregory.

Oregon finished fifth last year in the national tournament in Davis, Calif., and have a goal of finishing fifth again this year. But team spokesman Todd Robertson said the team is capable of finishing higher.

Robertson said players who graduated from the team last season were replaced by other players who are as good or even better than the graduated players. Robertson also said the team is much better organized this year than last.

The Ducks have four players returning from last year's team

including Robertson, team captain Eric Anderson, Nasser Ansary and setter Earl Richmond. Six-foot-4 middle blocker Troy Furutani highlights the new players on the team.

The starting six includes those five players with a three-man rotation in the sixth spot. Grant Goodban, who played on

the Downtown Athletic Club last year, joins Steve Dalton and Jason Smith in the rotation.

Men's volleyball coach Russ Saltmarsh also is a member of the Downtown Athletic Club team, but will be on the bench for the Oregon team tonight.

The game is open to the public at \$2 per ticket.
