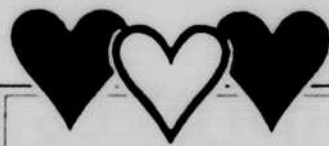

Buechler earns honor

Laurie Merlino and Amy Mickelson of Washington were named Monday as Pac-10 co-players of the week in women's basketball, while Arizona forward Jud Buechler was named on the men's side. It was the second time this season Buechler has garnered player of the week honors.

Michelson and Merlino scored 24 and 22 points, respectively, in Washington's 81-78 win over second-ranked Stanford in Seattle on Saturday.

The win enabled the Huskies

to jump from seventh to fifth in the weekly Associated Press women's basketball poll. Stanford fell to third.

Buechler averaged 18 points and 12.5 rebounds in Arizona's weekend sweep of Southern California and UCLA. The 6-foot-6 senior from Poway, Calif. had 19 points, 12 rebounds and eight assists against the Trojans and burned the Bruins for 17 points and 13 rebounds.

He also held UCLA standout Don MacLean to nine second-half points in the Wildcats' box-and-one defense.
