

Oregon wrestlers take down OSU

The University wrestling team completed a season sweep of Oregon State by posting a 23-11 victory in McArthur Court Friday night.

The dual meet win, which was the eighth in a row for the Ducks, pushed Oregon's season record to 10-1. The Beavers fell to 15-12-1.

Oregon jumped out to an early 13-0 lead by winning the first four matches of the contest, then coasted on for the win as Oregon State never drew closer than seven points.

Oregon 118-pounder Dan Vidlak started the Ducks off in a manner befitting their No. 18 national ranking by punishing OSU junior Randy Price, 14-4.

Vidlak, the nation's sixth-ranked 118-pounder, dominated Price, scoring five take-downs during the seven-minute battle.

The Ducks then built their largest lead of the night, earning victories at 126, 134 and 142 pounds to open up a 13-point advantage.

At 126 pounds, Oregon junior Rob Stone shut out OSU frosh David Graham 7-0.

The closest match of the night came at 134 pounds, where Duck freshman Jason Jones defeated OSU newcomer Lee McDiarmid, 4-3.

Jones built up a 4-2 lead in the first round then held on for the one-point win.

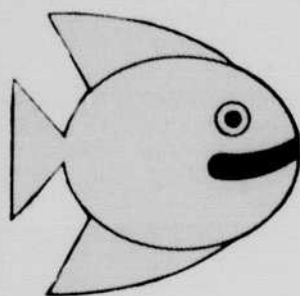
The Ducks then got an outstanding performance from 142-pounder Scott Glenn. Glenn beat OSU's Neil Russo by a count of 6-0 in a match that looked closer on paper than it did on the mat. Russo boasted a 20-10-2 mark coming

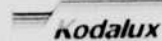
