has for the trip to Los Angeles, and that is his team's health. The flu bug has hit the Ducks in recent weeks, and it could be a factor this weekend.

Heiny is still very confident about his team's postseason chances.

"I even think that if we would happen to lose to UCLA, there's still a chance to get in," Heiny said.

Should the Ducks achieve the 20-win mark this season, it is no guarantee of an NCAA bid. Twenty wins is something that the tournament committee looks at, and they sometimes even look at numbers below that, Heiny said.

However, NCAA officials have never taken a Pac-10 team into the tournament with fewer than 21 wins.

The Ducks are currently 16-7 overall, with six games left on their schedule. Four of those

six game are on the road.

Heiny also points out that the losses they have incurred came against some respectable teams — a point that favors the Ducks for postseason play. Five of those seven losses have come to teams currently ranked in the Top 25.

a very good team in this region," Heiny said. "I think we need to be third. I don't know if the fourth team will get in (to the tournament)."

The Ducks do have the Bruins beat in the overall record department. UCLA, 14-9 overall, would be helped tremendously by a victory against the Ducks.

Monson will be assisted by Bruce Haroldson of Pacific Lutheran and David Yanai of Cal State, Dominguez Hills in coaching the West team.

The seventh-year coach has a 95-105 mark at Oregon and a 12-year overall ledger of 185-146. The Idaho graduate has taken five teams to postseason tournaments. Monson's Ducks are currently 13-10 on the 1989-90 season.

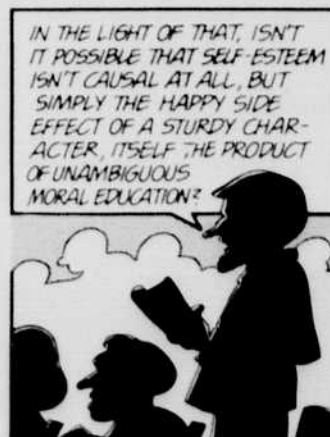
