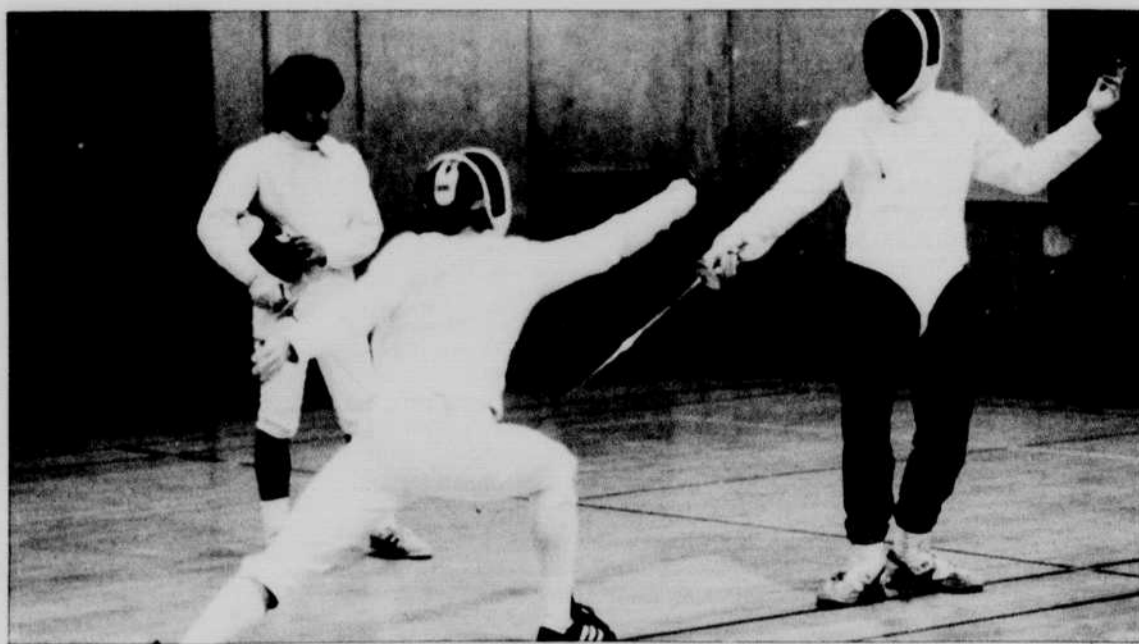

Fencing club to host meet

Room 220 Gerlinger Hall will be the site for the Pacific Northwest Collegiate Fencing Championship meet Saturday morning at 10.

Oregon Club Fencing will send eight contestants into the meet, which will feature fencers from up to eight schools. Oregon State, Portland State, Washington State and Lewis and Clark College have been invited as well as Clark and Clatsop Community Colleges.

Club fencing spokesman Owen Mikasa said all the above have been invited, but it is not certain who will show.

Competition in the meet will be split into two divisions. The foil competition will feature Oregon fencers Jeff Jirod, Karl Herber, Jim Smirch, John Fogarty, David Hurley and Mikasa.

The saber event will have Oregon contestants Joel White and Cedar Ingbar.

Mikasa, who will be defending his Pacific Northwest championship in the foil event, said rules in foil fencing require the contestant to score by making contact with his or her opponent with the tip of the weapon. He said the foil weapon is lighter than the saber.

In the saber event, contestants use the edge of the weapon to score rather than the tip.

The meet is open to the public.

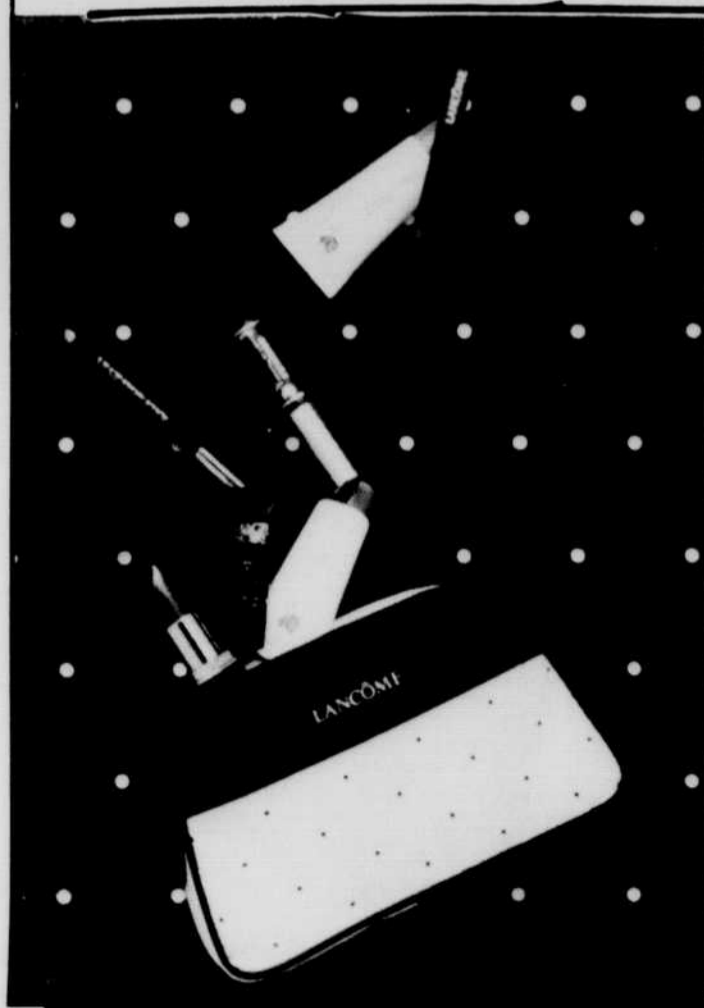
