group falls short of funds, it is welcome to come to the IFC with a request.

In addition, the organization has the option to appeal.

The American Ad Federation chapter received \$3,830 in funding for next year's budget after clarifying its membership fee policy. Only students who want to become national AAF members must pay dues, President Shelley Dement said.

The IFC had tabled the chapter's budget request at the Feb. 16 hearing because of the membership fee issue. The IFC voted 5-1 to fund the chapter Thursday night, with Maples abstaining.

Two groups that failed to attend the last meeting received allocation for the 1990-91 budget season.

Whitebird Rideshare received \$3,892 for the 1990-91 budget. Director Robert Dritz apologized for missing the previously scheduled meeting, saying he was ill.

The Pre-law Student Society received \$455 for the 1990-91 budget season. President Laurie Callanan said that "somehow

or other" she was not informed of the meeting.

U of O Song and Dance did not appear at Thursday's meeting as scheduled, and Big Time Poetry Theater did not submit a budget to the ASUO Executive.

wide procedure was adopted, some departments had a grievance procedure to follow and others didn't, said Marlene Drescher of the Office of Student Advocacy.

"In the past, grievances were filed without a set of rules," Drescher said. "The new rules provide a structure governing how grievances are addressed."

A committee was appointed in 1988 by former University President Paul Olum to draft a grievance rule. The committee solicited input from various organizations and eventually submitted a final document for formal approval.

A public hearing was then held to gather input on the fi-

nal document. Drescher said formal comments from the Office of Student Advocacy were incorporated as promulgated.

One concern Drescher has about the new policy is that the new rule mandates a choice of formal proceedings, she said.

"Students can select one and only one formal process," she said. "It remains our concern that a student may select the departmental grievance procedure which is not necessarily set up to deal with a grievance case."

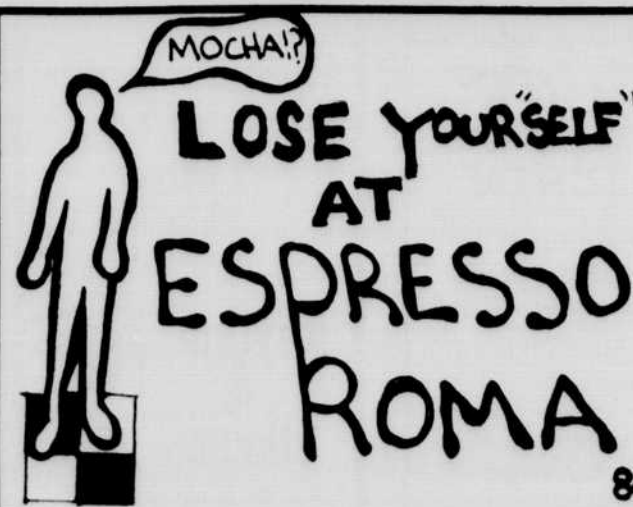
Drescher said in general she is happy with the new rules and that there is now a structure students can follow that will address their grievances.
