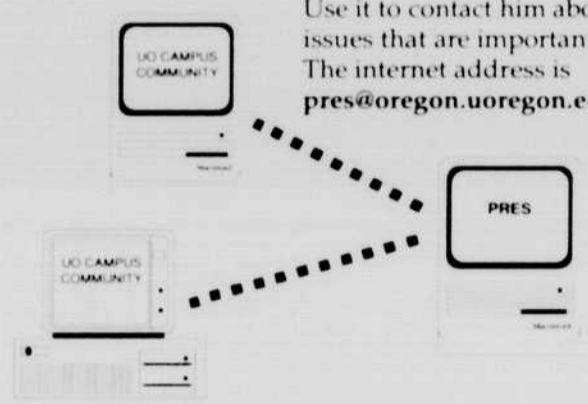

Law school shootings suspect arrested Friday

A man seen shooting out windows at the University law school building, and then at gas pumps at a local service station, was arrested early Friday morning according to an Office of Public Safety spokesperson.

Richard A. Eisenberg, 29, was arrested at the corner of High Street and East Broadway shortly before 4 a.m.

A witness reported seeing Eisenberg walk up behind a tree and shoot out the main glass doors of the law school with a 12-gauge shotgun at 3:17 a.m. Eisenberg then allegedly drove away in a red Toyota Tercel.

At 3:41 a.m., Eisenberg was reportedly seen at the British Petroleum station at 29th Avenue and Willamette Street. Eisenberg shot out four pumps and some windows at the station with a 12-gauge and a .22-calibre rifle then left, police say.

A few minutes later, a Eugene Police Department lieutenant stopped Eisenberg in his car at the corner of High Street and East Broadway. A 12-gauge shotgun and a .22-calibre rifle were found in the car, according to the report.

After being identified by the witness who saw him shoot at the law school and the BP station, Eisenberg was arrested and taken to Lane County jail. He was booked for first-degree criminal mischief, a felony, and reckless endangerment, a class A misdemeanor.

Early Wednesday morning, three windows looking out of the law school's admissions office were shot out by a 12-gauge shotgun. EPD and OPS officers arrived too late to see a suspect, but said they did see a red Toyota Tercel leave the area.

A total of \$3,000 damage was done to the law school, while \$20,000 damage was done to the BP station. There were no injuries in any of the incidents.
