fore the players on practice days to set up. He brings the balls, water bottles and clocks up to the court and helps the players with any equipment problems they may have.

During the practice, McMenomy runs the clocks for the coaches and runs any necessary errands. After practice, he waits until everybody has left and then puts everything away.

During home games, McMenomy is in charge of laying out the players' uniforms and organizing the moppets. The moppets are the young children who help sweep and wipe up the court at home games.

McMenomy is also responsible for helping to take care of teams that are visiting Mac Court.

"If a team has a practice or shoot around scheduled at M.C.," McMenomy said, "I'm required to be around during it

to get them whatever they need or if I can't be there to make sure somebody is there for them."

Most jobs have a good side and a bad side to them, and McMenomy's is no different.

"My favorite part of the job is when we win because it puts everybody in a good mood and that makes my job easier," McMenomy said. "On the other hand, the worst part of the job is probably carrying all the bags of the road."

McMenomy's hours on the job are long, but he isn't complaining. He receives a full scholarship for his efforts out of Coach Monson's basketball budget. This combined with the chance to travel makes the package too good to turn down.

"Coach Monson has been great to me," McMenomy said. "I've met a lot of managers who don't receive full scholarships, but Coach Monson feels my job is important enough and that means a lot to me."

McMenomy feels that he has adapted to his position after a rough beginning. He took over for Curtis Nelson after the 1987-88 season and found things a little overwhelming at first.

"It was like somebody threw me into a pool and I had to learn how to swim to survive," McMenomy said, "but now I feel that I have a good grasp of my responsibilities and do a solid job."

You can look for McMenomy on the sidelines next season as well. He expects to graduate next spring after another year of managing the team. He is a rhetoric and communication major who carries a 3.15 grade point average.
