think probably 75 to 80 percent of our students were already taking a course on race or gender studies already."

In requiring students to take a course dealing with other races, ethnic groups or cultures, the University is leading other schools in what Holbo feels is a new trend.

"I think we're a little ahead on this one," Holbo said. "Portland State University is looking at doing this, and Oregon State University is looking at doing something a little different. They require a course that is just non-Western."

The renumbering of courses follows a mandate from the Oregon State System of Higher Education. Changes will appear in the fall 1990 course catalog.

"Students who are here right now will notice subtle changes," said Holbo. "Courses will have different numbers. If they wanted to finish a cluster, they may find that the class has disappeared. It's the task of aca-

demic advising to make sure that there is an alternative course to fill that."

"Beginning next fall, all the 'C's and 'M's will drop off the course numbers," Holbo added. "Instead, there will be 600 and 700 level courses - that's statewide, not just at the University."

The proposed curriculum changes also include revisions of the Bachelor of Arts and Sciences field requirements.

"We've sort of streamlined what we call the field requirements," Holbo said, noting that science is no longer required for a B.A. and math for the B.S. We assume that if you're a chemistry major, for instance, you're taking the science anyway."

Clusters have been renamed as sequences, something the student senators complained of at the meeting.

"I have always felt the cluster concept was a good

program, but the term was very confusing. I think this will be easier to work with, for advisers and students," said Holbo.

The curriculum at the University was last reviewed prior to the 1988-89 academic year, before preparations for the fall 1990 switch to the semester system halted any curricular changes. The task of almost completely revising the curriculum to the semester system was nearly completed when the state board canceled the plans.

Holbo expects some problems from the changes. "I think for a year or so we're going to be finding errors," Holbo said. "It's sort of fine tuning."

Senate recommendations on the curriculum report will go before the University Assembly March 14.

The final version of the report, incorporating amendments and any changes the senate or assembly makes will be issued two weeks after the assembly approves the curriculum.
