

Women face Pilots

Women's tennis coach Tom Greider sees Thursday and Friday's home matches with the University of Portland and Portland State as a tune-up of sorts.

After playing two tough teams at UC-Davis and Pacific last week in California, the Ducks will have it a little easier this week against the Pilots and the Vikings.

"It's a chance to practice some skills and it's March so we can play outdoors," Greider said.

The Ducks meet Portland Thursday at 2 p.m. and Portland State Friday at 3:30 p.m. Oregon beat the Vikings 9-0 earlier in the season, but missed a chance to play against the Pilots because of bad weather in January.

However, Greider knows enough about the two teams that Oregon should be able to improve on its 3-3 season record.

"I think there are four or five levels of play (in college tennis)," Greider said. "Stanford is at the top and Portland is at the bottom or the level right above that. I

put us somewhere in the middle along with Pacific and Davis and I'm a firm believer in that."

Greider made it clear, however, that he wasn't trying to provide added inspiration for the Pilots, just that the skill levels between the two schools are so vast.

But, like any other opponent, Greider believes the Ducks have to be ready to play.

Thursday's home match against Portland will be Oregon's fourth home match of the season and the Ducks are currently 2-1 at home.

"We're excited because we have four straight matches at home," Greider said.

Greider said he sees Friday's match against Portland State much the same way he views Thursday's match.

"We already beat them 9-0, so again I have the same philosophy for that match," he said. "We want to do some of the things we don't normally get a chance to work on such as coming to the net, working on chip shots, lobs and drop shots."

After meeting Portland and Portland State, Oregon will host Whitman on Sunday.

Women golfers place ninth in Utah tourney

The Oregon women's golf team took ninth place in the 18-team Utah-Dixie Classic golf tournament Tuesday in St. George, Utah, with a score of 989, 63 strokes behind tournament winner and host Brigham Young.

Lynn Yonemoto was the highest finisher for the Ducks at 33rd with a score of 246. Shannon Maier shot a 247,

good for 37th. Anna Pianalto shot a 250 for 47th place followed by Amy Eileff at 52nd with a 252 score. Nancy Crawford shot a 241 to finish 70th.

Kansas, U.S. International, Texas A & M, Washington State, Missouri, Oregon and Baylor rounded out the top 10 team scores.

The Oregon women's next competition will be March 26.
