## Men set for Pac-10 tournament

Seeking its second NIT bid in three years. Oregon hopes to build on its already surprising season in the fourth and final Pacific-10 Conference tournament, when the Ducks open play against UCLA Friday at 2 p.m. MST.

Oregon, which went to the NIT in 1988 and finished that season 16-14, has made a complete turnaround from an 8-21 season last year and is thinking about postseason play once again.

The Ducks, 15-12 overall after finishing at 10-8 and fifth in the Pac-10, meet the Bruins, 18-9 overall after completing conference play at 11-7 to finish fourth, in the quarterfinals of the tournament in Arizona State's Activity Center in Tempe where the tournament is being held this year.

Friday's game matches two teams that met two weeks ago in McArthur Court with Oregon winning 105-99 on the strength of 65 percent shooting from the floor. The Bruins won the first meeting in Pauley Pavilion. 79-62.

Although Oregon coach Don Monson doesn't think the Ducks need to shoot 65 percent from the field to beat UCLA again, he knows Oregon will still have to play a good game

be over 60 percent, but I know we'll have to be over 50 percent." Monson said. "We've been a pretty good shooting kind of team all year and we're right around 50 percent for the


