You may be eligible for a research study if you are over 21 and suffer from anxiety, worry, nervousness, inner tension and physical symptoms of stress (headache, sweating, dry mouth, pounding heart, etc.) This research has been federally approved and is taking place in several large cities. If you meet the criteria for generalized anxiety disorder without a seriously depressed mood, you may receive free screening and medical treatment for up to two months. Individuals with alcohol or drug abuse, or poorly controlled medical problems cannot be accepted for this research. Women of childbearing potential must be using a medically acceptable form of birth control.
