Radio station will go up for vote KRMA could be on the air by fall term

A new campus radio station may be formed by fall term if students approve a funding measure during next month's ASUO elections.

If the ballot measure passes, Radio Music Alternatives, call letters KRMA, will be allowed to request funding from incidental fees.

James January, coordinator of Campus Radio, said \$25,861 is needed to buy production equipment and a microwave disc. Studio equipment

has been donated by KWAX, the University's fine arts radio station.

"This is important because without money we can't get equipment, and without equipment we can't do the programming," January said.

Campus Radio supporters have gathered 1,755 signatures to place their measure on the April 26-27 ballot.

KRMA will be holding fund raiser concerts with local artists, he said. The station will also
